Using magazines and newspapers, they cut out images, words, or phrases that represent them, visually sharing their passions and interests.	<b>SHOT COMPOSITIONS</b> To create videos and take photos, it's essential to understand the type of shot and framing to use. Participants become directors and actors, interacting with one another to experiment with the shot compositions previously analyzed with the group.	<b>COMPOSITE IMAGES</b> Participants experiment with layering techniques. The goal of the activity is to create a three-layer image, where each layer is a sheet of transparent paper and the background is a colored card or photograph. At the end, the assembled image is digitized using Adobe Photoshop.	<b>FLAT LAY</b> Participants, working in groups, explore the flat lay photography technique. Using available objects, they create a composition to tell their story through a photo, refining their editing skills to enhance colors and textures.	<b>MINIATURE LEGO ADVENTURE</b> This activity encourages participants to reflect on perspective by entering the miniature world of Lego characters. Participants capture impactful photos where Lego figures interact with real-world objects and human environments.
